Wi-Fi Connection

The University of Siena belongs to the **EduRoam network** (Education Roaming). EduRoam is a service that offers secure wireless access to users from the international scientific community. Guest users are able to access the University of Siena's wireless network using their institute's credentials (username and password), without the need for further formalities. You may need to run the EduRoam Configuration Assistant Tool (CAT) to connect your device, which can be found at **https://cat.eduroam.org**

Another option available to temporary guests is the **UnisiConference WiFi network**. Access to this network is protected by a password that is updated every week. The password will be made known to all participants in the Conference Venue.

Slide Desk



Social Dinner

Visit the National Antarctic Museum

Only a 50-metre walk separates the Alpine Workshop venue from the 'Felice Ippolito' National Antarctic Museum. The exhibits of the Museum shows the history of scientific exploration on the Antarctic continent and touches on research topics such as geology, glaciology, paleoclimatology, biology, atmospheric, marine sciences, and thematic cartography. Information is provided through showcases with rock samples, meteorites, volcanic bombs, fossils, organism preparations, posters and information technologies.

The museum is open every day from 9:00 to 15:00, admission is free (you just have to get there) and the museum staff will be happy to introduce you to the exhibits and various aspects of geological research in Antarctica.
